## What's New for 2009

In 2009, it is 400 years since Galileo Galilei first aimed his telescope at the sky. This year is therefore designated the "International Year of Astronomy" and the Tycho Brahe museum is more popular than ever.

### Outdoor Exhibition

This year's outdoor exhibition takes basis in the International Year of Astronomy, so Arne Ardeberg, Professor of Astronomy at the University of Lund, has been asked to produce the exhibition. The theme of the exhibition was obvious - Modern Astronomy, with a focus on a project called E-ELT.

E-ELT is an abbreviation for "European Extremely Large Telescope"; a project that Arne Ardeberg leads. The exhibition tells about this extremely large telescope that will be built during 2015 and placed somewhere in Europe. The exhibition focuses on telling the benefits of a telescope of this size: What can we see in the universe with this tool that we can not see today? What can we expect to find?

The exhibition opens May 9.

### Playground

The museum playground will be expanded and improved. The focus of the playground is on telling the history of old games and sports and the idea is that children and adults will play and have fun together while learning about our history.

The playground opens June 1.

### Renaissance Market 18 - 19 July

In 2009, the museum's renaissance market is larger than ever. Craftsmen, artists, musicians and jesters all gather at the museum area to entertain and show their many skills.

### Harvest festival

On October 17-18 a harvest festival is held in our renaissance garden where the museum's gardeners will sell the season's vegetables, fruits and plants. The museum's cafe serves warm soups that can be enjoyed in a glowing autumn park. Our guides offer to show the museum facilities and the museum shop has a sale.

### Guided Tours

During the season the Tycho Brahe museum offers guided tours of the museum on a daily basis. In addition to this, the museum also leads guided tours along the Planet path and dramatized tours at fixed times during the summer. For more information please visit our website.
